SNOW FLURRY pressed the pace along the inside, dropped back on the turn, angled out at the top of the lane, closed willingly and wore down her rivals to get up late. JOLIE CANDY came out at the start, raced seven wide to the turn, vied to deep stretch, inched away and was caught late. AMERICAN CHERUB broke sharply, was carried out on the turn, swung wide into the stretch, closed well and got up late for show. DANNYBOB vied to the sixteenth pole, faltered, dropped back and was caught for third. POP'S PARTY broke out, was carried out on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, continued in a steady bid and didn't have enough late. SILVER ABSTRACT raced close early, bore out on the turn, dropped back and lacked a stretch response. GABRIELLA WHO trailed the field.
