TED stalked the pace, bid off the rail, closed steadily, got up late and was fully extended at the wire. READY TO STORM set a pressured pace past the sixteenth pole and was outfinished in a game effort. BLAZING TO GOLD pressed the pace, bid willingly, was unable to sustain his bid and held for show. WINNING BIG broke out, raced close to the pace along the inside, shifted out into the turn, went wide in the drive and found his best stride late. SANGER bobbled a bit at the start, stalked the pace towards the outside, rallied four wide on the turn, bid to loom a threat and came up empty late. AMERICAN SOLO failed to threaten in an even effort. DADDY WHAT IF broke out and bumped at the start, trailed the field and improved position. VINNIEBOB broke slowly and veered out at the start and was not a factor. COMING ABSTRACTION bumped at the start and was outrun. RYDERS UP showed little. AMERICAN EMPIRE bobbled at the start, raced mid pack, swung wide leaving the turn and stopped. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available.
