ROCKET SANDERS vied between horses early, dropped back into the turn, came again to duel for the lead and inched clear late to prove best. NABERS vied to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly in a good effort. HOLLAND was void of early speed, rallied around the turn, found his best stride late and got up for show. VINNIEBOB lacked a rally in a wide trip and failed to menace. CAPTAIN FABULOUS vied to mid stretch, faltered and lost position. HOLCOMBE trailed the field and improved position in a steady effort. KHANTARO D'ORO bobbled at the start and again early, put in an even effort and was outrun. CROSSRIGHTHANDS raced close inside, lacked a stretch response and steadily faded through the lane. LEWIS BERE (FR) raced mid pack in an even effort and was outrun. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available. Internal fractions have been removed and are not available.
