ONE MARK pressed the pace five wide, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled past the sixteenth pole and drew clear. AARON WHO set the pace to the turn, responded when challenged to duel past the sixteenth pole and yielded to finish second best. CHARLOTTE'S SPIDER pressed the pace four wide, dropped back on the turn, continued willingly and earned show. HENRY ON THE RUN was slow early and improved position in a steady effort. BE A PRO pressed the pace to the turn, dropped back, weakened in the drive and faded from contention. SNOW BOOTS broke out and bumped at the start and showed little in an even effort. JEEPS STRIDE was not a factor and showed little. MAXIMUM BULL bumped at the start and showed little in a wide trip. RYDERS UP was checked at the start, trailed the field and passed tiring rivals. INDY'S SONG raced close to the pace along the inside, dropped back into the turn and stopped. I'M A DREAMER TOO pressed the pace along the inside, dropped back into the turn and stopped. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available. Internal fractions have been removed and are not available.
