WHIMSICAL HEIR settled from the break, moved up three-wide through the turn, came four-wide into the stretch, finished well under steady handling, and edged clear near the finish line. ANNA B lagged early, then rallied up the rail to gain second. BROADWAY DISH chased close up inside, saved ground throughout, and finished evenly, lacking a winning kick. DANNYBOB made the lead from the outside without being asked, dueled with SHEZA HAILSTORM through the turn, came a little wide into the stretch, fought on gamely but was outfinished in the final furlong. UNIFIED A. P. stumbled exiting the gate, then lacked any early speed, chased the field down the backstretch, was last into the stretch but kept on late, and managed to pass a couple of foes near the wire. SHEZA HAILSTORM rushed up four-wide after a slow start, hooked in with DANNYBOB at the seven-sixteenths marker, dueled through the turn and into the stretch, and flattened out in the final furlong. QUITE LOVELY raced close up from the start, came under a drive midway through the turn, and faded late. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
