TRUTH SEEKER settled behind the dueling leaders down the backstretch, then moved up through the turn to bid two-deep near the quarter pole, spun out of the last turn with a slight lead, then finished up well under steady handling to win clear. HAM SANDWICH dueled in hand down the backstretch, took command passing the half-mile pole, then fought back when challenged by a pair of rivals approaching the quarter pole, responded when set down the stretch, then was outfinished by the winner. WINNING BIG lost the path at the start, settled behind the field from the break, moved over to the rail when clear, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, and produced a grinding finish 5-wide into the stretch to move up into third. MOHAY PLEASE broke well but was held up off the pace early, bid four-wide through the turn, pulled even three-deep turning for home, then went flat in the stretch. BEER MONEY dueled inside down the backstretch, gave way heading into the turn then had little left for the stretch run. BY DECREED was not asked for speed from the break, moved up between horses through the turn, came under pressure before the quarter pole, then weakened in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
