ANTONIOS MARK settled behind the pace battle, slipped through an opening along the rail at the top of the stretch, took command, and held sway under a steady hand ride. DIABOLICAL STORM pressed the pace three wide and won a spirited battle for the second prize. ONE MARK unhurried from the break, circled the field on the turn, bid six-wide into the stretch and finished up well for third. DRINKROUNDTHETRUTH pressed the early pace from between horses, was carried a little wide into the stretch, but kept on well. SIDEWINDER SLICK vied inside of several rivals for the early lead, took a slight lead into the turn, drifted out a couple of paths turning into the stretch, kept on well, then weakened inside the sixteenth pole. STORM LEADER hustled up after the start to view four-wide early, backed off the pace battle before the turn, came under pressure past the quarter pole, then was outkicked in the stretch. NEW MEXICO JEREMY settled inside mid-pack, struggled to keep pace through the turn and did not respond when asked in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
