JUST JANE was never far off the pace, raced inside, bid off the rail, wore down his rivals and got up near the wire. C'MON BREN vied between horses, dropped back on the turn, came again, led late and was caught near the wire to just miss. NEVER SURRENDER bumped at the start, put in a steady bid in an outside trip and got up for show. B D ONE raced close to the pace towards the outside, went willingly to the wire under a hand ride and was outfinished in a good effort. LOUIE'S MARK was void of early speed, angled out on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch and finished well. H M HOLY BAD BOY set a pressured pace, inched away on the turn, led past the eighth pole and stopped. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY was void of early speed, saved ground and lacked a stretch response. DAY RULER bumped on both sides at the start, showed speed to the turn and stopped. REMARKABLE ME bumped at the start, pressed the pace to the turn, stopped and was not urged late. FRACTIONS REMOVED.
