MISINFORMATION rated back near the inside, moved up from the inside through the upper lane, veered out deep stretch, forced Carl Erskine out, a stewards inquiry along with a jockey objection was filed and stewards deem Misinformation placed second for interference through the stretch run. CARL ERSKINE set a pressured early pace just to the outside of rival, dug in through the upper stretch, forced out deep stretch and finished gamely in a determined run. DANEYKO dropped back early, raced four wide through the far turn and moved up to improve position. DORMELLO'S LEGACY stalked the pace, raced three wide through the far turn and weakened a bit through the drive. ANOTHER JUANITO dropped back early, raced three wide near the quarter pole and failed to respond. TAPIT WARRIOR was off slowly, trailed early on and lacked a bid. PI TIME urged along early from the inside to press and stopped. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available. Internal fractions have been removed and are not available.
