BEETHOVEN J led the way between horses up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and drew off in the stretch. G B HARRISON stalked the leader on the outside through the early going, navigated the turn from the three path and kept on to the finish. CHARLIE THYME tracked the pace setter on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and chased on in the lane. SHINY SHORES chased the leader on the inside through the opening quarter, raced in the two path around the turn and finished evenly. EL HUARACHE PRIETO settled off the pace on the outside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the two path and passed tiring horses in the stretch. RUNAWAY HEAT raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, came around the bend in the four path and was outkicked in the lane. LIL BOB BLACK JACK raced in the middle of the pack between horses early, continued around the turn in the three path and was empty from there. JAZZ TIDE raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and faded in the stretch. MOTORMAN raced off the pace on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and made no bid. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
