GODSEND raced off the pace between horses up the backstretch, began a bid from the three path coming around the turn and kicked clear in the lane. BEAU VERO dueled on the outside up the backstretch, shook clear to lead the way from the two path while racing around the turn and was caught in the final sixteenth. SANGER chased the pace setters through the opening quarter, saved ground around the bend and kept on to the wire. DOM WAYNE raced in the middle of the pack early, navigated the turn from the two path and finished evenly. JUVAL raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and showed no kick. WE NEED MARKETING raced off the pace on the inside through the opening stages, came around the turn in the four path and was empty in the lane. ZACH WHO dueled on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and tired in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
