UNIFIED A. P. raced in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, began a bid entering the stretch and kicked clear. BIRDIE CURDY bumped with the horse to her inside at the start, chased the leader up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the four path and kept on in the lane. BOSTON PRINCESS bumped with the horse to her outside leaving the gate, recovered to lead the way up the backstretch, came around the bend in the two path and tired while drifting out in the final furlong. TURN ON ARCH raced in the middle of the pack on the inside through the opening quarter, continued around the turn in the three path and was outkicked in the stretch. JULIA'S PROMISE raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and never threatened. LOOKATHERGLIDE raced off the pace on the inside early, saved ground around the turn and made no bid. STREET MARK stumbled leaving the gate and lost her rider in the process, and was later caught and walked off. AN INQUIRY WAS MADE INTO THE START. UPON REVIEW, NO CHANGES WERE MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
