NEW YORK SCRAPPY angled in while hustled to the front, dictated terms in the two path while asked on the turn, extended the advantage outside the quarter-pole, drew off under a drive into the final furlong and proved much the best under steady urging. FORT NELSON was taken in hand behind the leader near the five-eighths pole then raced between foes, dropped back in the two path early on the turn, shifted to the three then four path later on that bend, dropped in under a drive in upper stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. MIDDLE MARKET was hustled from the gate, chased the pace on the inside, took an awkward stride while very close to the rail leaving the backstretch and dropped back, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. RULE SIXTY TWO tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path for most of the turn then moved to the four path, spun into the stretch in the five path and tired.

FULL POUR chased three then two wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying inside the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to prevail. EAGLE RISING chased three then four wide under urging from three furlongs out, went four wide into upper stretch and took over command straightened away, dug in under threat to the inside and tightened the rail on that rival, then got caught in the final strides by the outside rival and was forced to settle for the place honors. JULIET ON APPROACH coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, rallied up the inside and had EAGLE RISING come inwards and tighten the seam fairly without making contact when drawing alongside to be heads apart for command a sixteenth out, then got rebuffed through to the wire. LADY DELILAH four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, weakened. OUR PREFERRED PAL bobbed at the break, advanced inside to duel inside of ON A SUMMER DAY with five and a half furlongs to run, came under urging midway on the turn and shook off that rival, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. ON A SUMMER DAY showed the way early on from the two path before being engaged in a duel by the aforementioned rival with five and a half furlongs remaining, knocked heads through to the three-eighths pole, faded near the five-sixteenths and backed away to last before swinging five wide for home, then faltered in the drive.

PRINCESS NY pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the three path on the turn, was roused inside the three-eighths pole, fought with two foes under a drive into the final furlong, battled with a rival into the final sixteenth then disposed of that opponent and prevailed under strong urging. CARARRA was bumped lightly at the start, settled off the pace, moved closer near the nine-sixteenths pole, drafted in the two path for most of the turn, shifted to the three then four path outside the quarter-pole, was roused into upper stretch then moved out and finished willingly to just get the place. READY FOR TROUBLE was restless in the gate, stalked the pace after being taken in hand early, rounded the turn in the four path, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths then made a bid, turned into upper stretch on even terms for the lead, battled with two opponents into the final furlong, fought with the winner until the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished then just lost the place but earned the show. SHADYSIDE chased the pace on the outside, went around the turn in the five path, was driven into the stretch in the six path and lacked the needed kick. IN AWE OF JUJU broke out then made light contact with a foe, moved up to get the lead then set the pace under pressure to her outside, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch and gave way.

PROBLEMATICA coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside under some pressure from MAGGIE T to the outside, got set down spinning three to four wide into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in under lone threat and was caught in the final strides to the wire. ECHO IN ETERNITY broke a half a beat slow, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, continued in the two path into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. TROUBLED LUCK broke out at the start, chased four then three wide under urging from three furlongs out, went four to five wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish.
