TREATY OBLIGATION was well placed down the backstretch, came under urging in the two path on the turn, moved to the three path outside the quarter-pole, rallied into upper stretch then made a bid outside of two foes, gained the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with those two opponents to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. CELESTIAL GLAZE pressed the pace on the outside, took a short lead at the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the three then two path on the turn, fought on gamely with two rivals in the stretch, battled between horses late and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. ASLEEP AT EIGHT went to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, dropped from the two path to the inside very early on the turn, battled gamely with the top two in the stretch and just missed while clear for the show. TYPHOON FURY settled in a good position on the backstretch, saved ground while roused on the turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) stumbled at the start and broke a step slow, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the four path on the turn, dropped to the three path later on that bend then moved back to the four path and came up empty.

ALWAYS PRACTICAL chased just off the inside until angled out nearing the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying through the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to prevail. SHEER WILL chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn advancing on the front under urging from the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and took over the front straightened away, dug in under lone threat to the outside and was caught in the final strides to the wire. VANILLA broke out a step at the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn ridden along from three furlongs out, tipped four wide into upper stretch, ran on to garner the show honors. CASILDA showed the way in hand three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three then two wide into upper stretch under threat, yielded the front straightened away and weakened in the late stages. HEY COOKIE brushed the near side stall at the start and came under coaxing, chased along the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, weakened in the late going.

ADVENTURIST dropped from the four path to the three path early on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three then four path on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong, gained to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with the runner-up late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BARON OF SEALAND dropped from the two path to the inside early on the first turn, was placed under a vigorous hold while keen behind horses on that bend then rated off the pace, came under urging leaving the backstretch, moved from the rail to the two path early on the far turn, chased inside the winner into the final furlong, gained to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought on well to the finish and just missed while clear for second. AWESOME EMPIRE went to the front, was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, controlled the action through the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then came under the crop in upper stretch, led until the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken by the top two while well clear for the show. LANDAUER shifted from the two path to the three path early on the first turn, settled outside near the back, was urged along late on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the four to five path and lacked the needed response. LOU moved from the rail to the two path early on the first turn, was hard held going around that bend, settled at the rear, was urged along late on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. BLAME IT ON DADDY established a forward position early, dropped from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, came up empty in the three path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and retreated then was eased but walked off.

WITH THE ANGELS chased along the inside and then just off the inside, spun two to three wide at the quarter pole before tipping out an additional two paths straightened away, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong taking command just outside the sixteenth marker, then edged clear to the finish. TWIRLING BEAUTY led briefly early on before settling three wide in closest aim of the leader, advanced in the turn to press the pace coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three then two wide into upper stretch and took over command just inside the three-sixteenths, dug in under threat from flanking challengers and was caught near the sixteenth pole, dug in and preserved the place honors on the line. MY MAGIC WAND broke in a step under hustling at the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside down the backstretch before coming under increased pressure through the turn from the aforementioned foe, took the inside route into upper stretch, got collared just inside the three-sixteenths marker and kept on to the finish to secure the show honors. CUPID'S HEART bobbed at the break getting away last, chased six then five paths off the inside down the backstretch before heading three wide

through the turn, went five wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. ALL CLASS chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the wire. KHALI MAGIC coaxed from the gate, chased two to three paths off the rail down the backstretch before heading three to four wide through the turn, continued four wide for home and weakened in the stretch. RELIABLE LADY traded a bump at the start with GOODNIGHTNGODBLESS, chased three then five wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, went six wide into upper stretch and weakened. GOODNIGHTNGODBLESS traded a bump at the break with the aforementioned rival, chased just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and made no impact. NILO'S ROSE four then five wide in pursuit, got coaxed along three furlongs from home, tipped six wide into upper stretch, tired.
