LOTTIE MARGARET was carried out after the start, brushed with a foe entering the main-track then moved in with six furlongs to run, stalked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader in the four then three path on the turn, took over outside the quarter-pole, kicked clear into upper stretch, drew away under a drive until the sixteenth-pole then was eased up late while much the best. HOWLING WIND drifted out after the start, brushed with a foe entering the main-track then moved in near the three-quarter pole, tracked the pace on the inside of a rival, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the two path on the turn, shifted to the four path into the stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. CARA'S DREAMWEAVER was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path and came up empty while best of the rest. NINA KAY ducked in at the start, was urged along while setting the pace, vied inside on the turn, lost the advantage to the winner outside the quarter-pole and faded. HONORABLE BECKY was last into stride, settled near the back, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and failed to respond.

RESILIENT HERO coaxed from the gate, chased five then four wide down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the turn, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole and went five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge to take over command just inside the eighth pole, then edged away to the finish kept to task. THE TIRE MAN brushed the near side stall at the start, chased four then three wide advancing on the leader inside seven-sixteenths to run coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, seized command just outside the quarter pole and went three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared just inside the eighth pole, ran on clear for the place honors. OUTSOURCE broke with the field albeit last and was outrun early on growing detached at the tail of the field along the inside, got ridden along half a mile from home and saved ground through the turn, spun three wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to garner the show honors. LETS FIGHT chased three then two wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, weakened. ASSET MANAGEMENT chased along the inside under encouragement from three furlongs out, tipped three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. ISLAND CHARLIE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under urging nearing the five-sixteenths when under pressure for the initial time, yielded the front and spun just off the inside into upper stretch, then tired through to the finish.

VOLLEYBALLPRINCESS showed speed then set the pace under pressure to her outside, shook clear at the seven-sixteenths pole, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, had the rider lose his crop while trying to un-cock it inside the three-sixteenths pole and drew off under a strong hand-ride to prove much the best. OURDAYDREAMINGGIRL stumbled at the start and was last away but broke relatively with the rest of the field, moved out at the rear then dropped well behind under urging, moved from the four path to the two path early on the turn, swung back out to the four path into the stretch and finished with good energy to garner the place. HOLLYWOOD BEAUTY moved in while showing speed then pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back under urging leaving the backstretch, chased in the two to three path on the turn, spun into upper stretch in the four path and weakened while able to get the show. MOONLIT DRIVE tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path for most of the turn then moved to the two path, came back into the three path into upper stretch, dropped back while remaining on her inside until outside the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead when pulled in by the rider and tired. WIN N YOUR IN was hustled from the gate, moved off the rail early on the backstretch, was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and came up empty.

R FUNNY BIZNESS coaxed from the gate, chased two then three wide down the backstretch before tucking back to the two path half a mile from home before making her way to the rail at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled three wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path a furlong out, rallied inside the final eighth to issue a challenge a sixteenth out and was up in the final jumps to the finish. POSEIDON'S MIST hustled from the start, showed the way in hand four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing threat and came outwards to the finish under a left handed crop and was caught in the final strides to the wire. DASHING DELLA chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, swung six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. MYSARIA chased five then three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide at the top of the stretch, tired.

LOOKIN TO ROCK was hustled from the gate, angled in entering the main-track, was urged along off the pace, saved ground on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, moved out while rallying in the final furlong and closed well to go past the runner-up in the final sixteenth and prevail. NELSON AVENUE chased three then two wide under coaxing from three furlongs out, cornered three wide into upper stretch, faltered in the drive.

SUNDAY GIRL chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in under threat to the outside and gamely rebuffed the challenge to prevail. EVERYONELOVESLINDA coaxed from the start, chased four then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, ran on through to the finish but was ultimately repelled by the top one while clear for the place honors. PROUD FOOT was unprepared for the start when the assistant starter was unable to get up on the side and settled for the break when the latch was sprung and made inadvertent contact with the rider, got away last and conceded four to five lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased four to five paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, went five wide into upper stretch and improved position to secure the show honors. GOLDEN DEGREE cut the pace three paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking inside into the turn, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front nearing the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. SHESALITTLE EDGY chased along the inside and then just off the inside under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled four wide into upper stretch, made no impact. WILLOW BEND chased three wide until tucked inside through the turn, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, tipped four to five wide into upper stretch and tired.

STRONG LIGHT broke a step slow, went around the first turn in the two path, moved out early on the backstretch, reached the outside of the field with five furlongs to run then made a strong middle move, gained to make a bid coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, took the lead while dropping from the five path to the three path on the far turn, battled outside of the runner-up under a drive into the final sixteenth and edged clear late under good handling. BOLD VICTORY went around the first turn in the five then four path, settled on the outside, came under urging when joined by the winner to the outside near the nine-sixteenths pole, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied between horses while dropping from the four path to the two path on the final turn, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while well clear for the place. PORTOS broke near the back of the field, saved ground on the first turn, was coaxed along on the backstretch, raced inside under urging for most of the far turn then shifted to the two path, came out to around the five path into upper stretch then quickly drifted out, was bumped soundly by a rival outside the furlong marker and improved for the show. WILD BANKER rounded the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was roused in the four path on the far turn and lacked the needed response. BADLANDS RULER was hustled to the front, showed the way on the inside, was headed outside the three-eighths pole, dropped back into upper stretch, drifted out in the drive and tired. HELIUM shifted from the two path to the rail early on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, dropped back under urging late on the backstretch, moved from the three path to the rail on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the two path and came up empty. BECAUSE THE NIGHT raced in the four then three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, chased in the two to three path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, came out and bumped soundly with a rival outside the furlong marker and capitulated. JANSSEN was hustled from the gate, moved from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, prompted the pace between horses, came up empty after going five furlongs and faltered then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
