OIL CAPITAL coaxed from the gate, dueled from the two path with FREE SPIN to his outside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat a furlong out, edged clear kept to task to the finish. FREE SPIN broke out at the start under coaxing and bumped MR R T into ANTIETAM, dueled four then three wide with the aforementioned foe to his inside, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, got shaken off and ran on to come again and secure the place honors. FROSTELLE chased five then four wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths marker, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid latching on the leader straightened away, got shaken off inside the furlong grounds and kept on to preserve the show honors on the wire. COPIOUS broke slow when a bit awkward with the rider against the bit at the start, chased just off the inside down the backstretch before tipping three then four wide through the turn under coaxing from the half mile pole, continued four wide into upper stretch and offered up a belated bid. GUALILLO broke out at the start and was steadied when losing his lane to ANTIETAM, chased six then five wide under urging from three furlongs out, continued six wide into upper stretch and offered no rally. ANTIETAM got bumped at the start by MR R T due to pressure from FREE SPIN, chased three then two wide under encouragement with seven-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. MR R T got bumped at the start by FREE SPIN and in turn bumped ANTIETAM, chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired.

DANIELLA MARIE broke a step slow then was hustled, moved up into third position under urging, chased in the three path on the turn, gained in the four path into the stretch, took the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, shook clear inside the furlong marker and drew away while kept to the task under mild urging. OHOOPEE was restless in the gate, came away in good order then angled in while going to the front, dictated terms while inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch, battled with that foe into the final furlong and proved no match while clear for the place. ST. BRIGID'S CROSS was sent hard from the start, moved out early then chased the pace, went around the turn in the two path and weakened while just able to get the show. KAREY was urged along at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path on the turn and lacked the needed response then just missed the show. BASEBALL LADY dropped back towards the rear then was urged along well off the pace, climbed late on the backstretch and into the turn, went around that bend in the three then four path and was no factor. ADMIRAL SOL was urged along off the pace, dropped back while climbing some leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. BELLORO broke a step slow, moved up while urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the four path, spun into the stretch in the five path and capitulated.

CONCORDE SPIRIT got bumped at the start by CORVUS, who broke outwards, raced two then three wide through the first turn briefly carrying out SANZIO four wide midway on that turn, settled four paths off the inside down the backstretch in aim of the top pair, continued four wide through the far turn patiently handled until placed to urging just outside the quarter pole, swung six wide into upper stretch, seized command straightened away, edged clear under a drive to prevail. CORVUS broke out at the start bumping the aforementioned foe, dueled in hand inside of MAD BANKER coming under coaxing three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. MAD BANKER coaxed from the start, raced three then two wide through the first turn advancing to knock heads with the aforementioned rival seven furlongs from home, dueled in hand just off the inside down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths marker, spun three wide into upper stretch, kept on under a drive to preserve the show honors. CADDIEMASTER grew a bit fractious just before the latch was sprung, broke in at the start and was corrected, chased two then three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. BERNING BEAUTY raced along the inside through the first turn and then chased three wide thereafter, came under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, tipped four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. LANDAUER chased two to three wide under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, swung three to four wide at the head of the stretch, weakened. SANZIO brushed the off side stall at the start, raced three wide into the first turn and was carried out four wide by CONCORDE SPIRIT midway, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the far turn, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

YO DADDY coaxed from the gate, raced along the inside through the first turn and then two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, remained two to three wide through the far turn before tipping four wide nearing the five-sixteenths placed to urging, advanced and swung four wide into upper stretch and took over command with three-sixteenths to go, then edged away under a drive to prevail. CLASSICIST hustled from the gate, raced three wide in aim of the front, advanced to vie for the front midway on the far turn before emerging with sole but narrow command near the quarter pole, continued three wide for home, got caught with three-sixteenths to run and ran on to chase the winner home clear for the place honors. DREAMLIKE raced four then three wide into the first turn before briefly tucking to the two path midway, tipped back out to be four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then briefly six paths off the rail near the half mile pole, went three wide through the far turn coaxed along from that station, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. BOUNTY BANKER brushed with a foe at the start, was well placed just off the pace, drafted in the two path on the turn, steadied briefly in traffic inside the five-sixteenths pole then was roused, turned into the stretch in the four path, pursued the winner while remaining on his inside lead into the final sixteenth, swapped to the proper lead while gaining shortly thereafter and closed to just miss while well clear for the place. ICE HOUSE bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled to the lead, showed the way on the inside of a rival, vied along the rail on the turn, lost the advantage to the winner outside the quarter-pole and weakened but was well clear for the show. POWER SPEED bumped with an opponent at the start, showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path while roused for more on the turn, was crowded some while dropping back late on that bend and tired. DIAMOND LIFE brushed with a foe at the start, was urged along off the pace, moved out outside the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the four then three path and failed to threaten.
