EXHIBITION ONLY broke in and made contact with a foe, angled in while going to the front, was well rated while showing the way off the inside, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, responded well when roused into upper stretch and drew off under strong urging to prove much the best. GULFY broke in then was hustled, chased the winner from second, went around the turn in the three path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and safely secured the place. FIRST BLESSING lost his footing at the start but broke in front then bumped with a foe, was well placed just off the pace, dropped back early on the turn, saved ground while hard ridden on that bend and came up empty but was able to get the show. WHERE'S YOUR BOOM was forced in at the start then bumped with another foe and dropped back, moved in at the rear, fell well behind the rest of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch and failed to threaten. NEIGH BABY moved in early then was urged along off the pace, came out late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the four path, spun into the stretch in the five path and came up empty. SWISS ARMY KNIFE broke in then bumped with a foe and was slow into stride, spotted the front a few lengths, gained with five furlongs to run, dropped back while moving from the two path to the four path on the turn, came into the stretch in the six path and had nothing left. JUST TIPSY broke in a tad then was bumped in the hindquarters after the start, was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the five path and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
