SEA VISTA showed speed then chased the pace on the outside, went around the turn in the two path, lost touch with the leader in upper stretch, gained on that faltering foe into the final furlong, took the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and held under steady urging. ROGER ROGER showed speed then dropped back inside the three-quarter pole, was urged along in third position, raced in the three path while hard ridden on the turn, pursued two rivals under a drive into the final furlong, gained on the winner into the final sixteenth and willingly earned the place. POP GOES THE WIZ was urged along on the inside, dropped back late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and improved along the rail for the show. IMPLACABLE was hustled to the front, moved clear outside the five-eighths pole, raced inside on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under a drive in upper stretch, shortened stride significantly into the final furlong, was collared while faltering outside the sixteenth-pole and capitulated. LIMO settled at the rear, moved out near the five-eighths pole, was urged along at the back, angled in leaving the backstretch, went around the turn in the two path and failed to threaten. POPPY'S TICKET was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, came out into the four path into the turn, dropped to the three path early on that bend and faltered.

PAIR OF SOCKS broke in at the start, chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside into the turn, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying inside the final furlong, seized command a sixteenth out and edged away to the finish to prevail. SOCIAL HOUR dueled two to three paths off the inside with UNCLE WILLIAM to his outside down the backstretch, shook off that rival a bit near the half mile pole and showed the way through the turn just off the inside, got set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under growing threat to the outside and was collared a sixteenth from home, ran on clear of the rest and along second best. SHOOT THE NICKEL chased three then two wide under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire. UNCLE WILLIAM dueled early on from the four path with SOCIAL HOUR to his inside, got shaken off a bit and tucked three wide through the turn giving chase, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. TRUST FUND three to four wide in pursuit, got ridden along three furlongs from home, continued three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. THIRTEEN G'S stumbled badly at the start and appeared to shy in when recovering from the breaking in PAIR OF SOCKS, had the rider lose both irons and veered outwards after the break growing further detached at the tail of the field as the rider got back into his irons, got guided inwards seven then six paths off the rail nine-sixteenths from home well behind, continued through the turn and went five wide into upper stretch and was eased along home to the finish.

KADENA broke out but was away in front then hustled, angled in early then showed the way with a clear advantage, dictated terms while dropping from the two path to the inside on the turn, responded well when asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch and drew off under strong urging. NEXT ON STAGE broke out and bumped very hard with a foe, was urged along off the pace, moved closer with five furlongs to run, chased inside on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and safely secured the place while no threat to the winner. GOODNIGHTNGODBLESS broke out at the start, dropped back towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn, turned into the stretch in the two path and improved for the show. CURRENT CLIMATE was hustled from the gate, moved out near the five-eighths pole then chased the leader, went around the turn in the three path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and tired. SHADYSIDE was hustled from the gate, dropped back while urged along, went around the turn in the four path and failed to respond. READY FOR TROUBLE was bumped very hard at the start then checked, spotted the front a few lengths, raced in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path and was no factor.

KAVANAUGH three wide through the first turn, chased three wide in closest aim of the leader, began to advance on that rival from the midway point on the far turn, seized command and swung five wide into upper stretch, shied out under a left handed crop at the three-sixteenths marker, then drew clear under a drive to prevail.
