FLAT ON was hustled to the front, raced inside on the first turn, was well rated while showing the way down the backstretch, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, responded well when roused outside the quarter-pole, drew off under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, remained under the crop until just before the sixteenth-pole then was eased up while much the best. KISMEHOLDMETHRLME was hustled from the gate, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, was well placed down the backstretch, came under urging around the nine-sixteenths pole then dropped to the inside, chased along the rail on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. SOLO EMPIRE established a forward position early, raced in the two path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the two path on the far turn and tired while best of the rest. BECAUSE THE NIGHT was last to commence, moved from the two path to the three path on the first turn, came out leaving onto the backstretch, was urged along at the rear, traveled around the far turn in the five path and showed little. SHAMATEUR was hustled from the gate then steadied briefly while in tight quarters early, came out entering the first turn, raced in the four path on that bend, tracked the pace on the outside, dropped back near the nine-sixteenths pole, retreated in the four then three path on the far turn and faltered.
