CELTIC PRINCE chased five then four wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, rallied to wear down the leader and take command a sixteenth from home, then inched away in the late stages. FREE DANCE coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. RUM CAY stumbled at the start, advanced to show the way in hand along the inside, came under coaxing under threat to the outside with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught a sixteenth out, kept on to preserve the show honors. NINE N FOUR chased four then two wide coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. ROCK STAR REBEL

coaxed from the start, chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then five wide through the turn coaxed along from three furlongs out, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. RUN WITH HONOR led early on and then chased three wide under a ride from midway on the turn, tipped out five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. E Z BOURBON broke in at the start bumping INTELLECTUAL, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coaxed along from the seven-sixteenths, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. INTELLECTUAL got bumped at the start by E Z BOURBON, who broke inwards, began to climb striding greenly when facing kickback and lost ground down the backstretch while three wide, tucked to the two path through the turn, went six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. KING SOLOMON got away to a rank start when the rider was off balance against the bit, his charge growing rank and tossing his head, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact.
