WILDCAT ANNIE broke a half-step slow, settled towards the rear, went around the turn in the two then three path, rallied in the six path at the three-sixteenths pole, closed well to get the lead nearing the sixteenth-pole, moved in closer to the runner-up while battling with that foe late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. GLOBAL CHARMER was sent hard from the gate, chased the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the turn, took a short lead in the four path near the three-sixteenths pole, led under a drive until just before the sixteenth-pole then was headed by the winner, fought on well with that foe to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. AWESOME ROBERTA showed speed then set the pace under pressure to her outside, vied along the rail while asked for more on the turn, lost the advantage late on that bend, chased the leaders into the final furlong and weakened but earned the show. TALE OF THE TAIL was urged along early then moved in near the five-eighths pole, shifted from the inside to the two path on the turn, came out into upper stretch, passed the three-sixteenths pole in the five path, remained on her inside while in pursuit of the vanguard into the final furlong, swapped to the proper lead when tugged in by the rider shortly thereafter and lacked the needed kick. EDDIE MARIE had her head turned at the start and was off slow, raced at the rear while coaxed along, moved closer in the three then four path on the turn, came out into upper stretch, passed the three-sixteenths pole in the seven path, remained on her inside lead in the drive and lacked the needed response. BUBBE DEAREST showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied between foes on even terms for the advantage while in the two path on the turn, took a short lead late on that bend, lost the advantage in the three path at the three-sixteenths pole, battled while remaining on her inside lead into the final furlong then swapped to the proper lead while dropping back and tired.

RADIO RED chased two then three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole, then edged clear to the finish to prevail. IGNITE THE LIGHT got brushed at the start by PAXSATIONAL due to pressure from WHAT'S UP BRO, chased just off the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. ANTONIO OF VENICE coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside down the backstretch, tipped two then three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. TIVY coaxed from the start, chased three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch taking narrow command at the quarter pole, dug in on even terms with IGNITE THE LIGHT straightened away, got collared just inside the eighth pole and kept on to the finish. WHAT'S UP BRO bobbled at the break recovering outwards and bumping PAXSATIONAL, raced forwardly placed latched on to the inside of the leader, had that rival tuck in front and was checked with nine-sixteenths to go and then got rank off heels along the inside, attempted to get out into the turn and was under a firm left grip slipping to the two path three furlongs from home, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and went three wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path nearing the eighth pole to follow the eventual winner and was outfinished to the wire. PAXSATIONAL got bumped at the start by WHAT'S UP BRO, who recovered outwards from a bobble, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths under threat from a pair, yielded the front taking the inside route into upper stretch, then weakened in the late stages.

SHERIFF BIANCO was hustled from the gate, established a good position just off the pace, was asked while in the two then three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, gained to make a bid at the furlong marker, took the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and edged clear late under strong urging. SHIPSATIONAL pressed the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, vied in the three then two path on the turn, took the lead into upper stretch, led under a drive until outside the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken while able to get the place. DOC SULLIVAN was hustled from the gate, moved in then was rated just off the pace, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths pole, chased inside to the two path on the turn, moved out while needing extra left-rein pressure in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. LOCKE AND KEY brushed with a rival at the start then dropped back, settled last but one, shifted from the rail to the four path going around the first half of the turn, was roused while still in the four path at the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong and weakened. MAMA'S GOLD brushed with a rival at the start, was hustled to the lead then set the pace under pressure to his outside, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the turn, was asked on that bend, lost the advantage into upper stretch and tired. WHITTINGTON PARK quickly dropped back while showing no speed, moved out then was ridden along at the rear, dropped in outside the five-eighths pole, rounded the turn in the two path and was no factor.

WAJDA disputed the pace on the outside then in the two path on the turn, dropped to the rail after shaking clear late on that bend, drew off while remaining on his inside lead into the final furlong, continued his inside lead to the finish and proved much the best under steady urging. SHAKIN THE BELLE was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and finished willingly for the place. DIALBOLICO disputed the pace on the inside of the winner, vied along the rail on the turn, dropped back late on that bend then moved to the two path, drifted out near the furlong marker and kept on to get the show. PRAIRIE DUNES was urged along near the back, raced in the three then four path on the turn, came into the stretch in the six path and improved position for the last spot in the superfecta. CHANGE YOUR NAME broke out and brushed with an opponent, was forwardly placed on the outside, raced in the three path under urging on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick. DANGEROUS DRIVER brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the five path and failed to threaten. FLYING IN STYLE showed speed then dropped back between horses outside the five-eighths pole, moved in leaving the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the two path and lacked the needed response. LCGOLUCKY was last to commence, raced at the rear under urging, moved from the rail to the two path late on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the four path and was no factor. DANCINGINTHEPARK ducked in at the start but broke with the rest of the field, settled off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, drifted out near the furlong marker and had nothing left.
