DOPPIO ESPRESSO was hustled from the gate, chased the pace from third, went around the turn in the two path, turned into upper stretch under the crop, had room between horses coming to the three-sixteenths pole then was bumped by the runner-up and paused, bumped a few times with that foe while getting back to the outside of the leader near the eighth-pole, continued to jostle into the final sixteenth, fought gamely between horses to the finish and prevailed under strong handling. HOLLY LN broke out at the start, moved up to track the pace on the outside, made a bid late on the backstretch, vied in the three path on the turn, came in at the three-sixteenths pole then bumped with the winner, bumped a few more times with that foe around the furlong marker, made a bid while continuing to jostle until near the sixteenth-pole, fought outside to the finish and missed but earned the place. DOLLY'S JOLENE went to the front then showed the way, was challenged late on the backstretch, vied inside while asked on the turn, inched away into the stretch, was challenged again while off the rail inside the furlong marker, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the show. ESSENCE L VEE broke out and was last away, settled well back on the outside, dropped from the two path to the inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. LUCKY LUCKY ME took an awkward stride early then dropped back, climbed behind a retreating opponent in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole then altered to the outside, went around the turn in the three path under urging, turned into the stretch in the four path and failed to threaten. PRIVATE CONNECTION chased the early pace under strong urging, tossed her head in the air near the eleven-sixteenths pole then retreated fast while climbing, dropped to the rear of the field while continuing to travel with a high head, raced behind a rival while inside early on the turn, shifted out to the three then four path coming to the three-eighths pole and was no factor. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE RIDER OF HOLLY LN CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. AFTER THE STEWARDS' REVIEW, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH

AWESOME EMPIRE was hustled from the gate then taken in hand early, raced a bit off the inside while rated just off the pace, drafted in the two path early on the turn, gained to make a bid inside the three-eighths pole, took over while set down in the stretch, fought outside of the runner-up until near the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. COCKTAILSNKRINGLE was hustled to the front then showed the way, vied inside on the turn, was asked under threat outside the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage to the winner into the stretch, battled with that foe until near the furlong marker and proved no match while able to hold the place. EXPLORATION settled off the pace, was roused in the three then four path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and finished willingly for the show. BRAVE BLEND was hustled from the gate, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, was asked in the three path on the turn, dropped back in the four path into the stretch and came up empty. GOLDEN PLATE was reserved at the rear of the field, saved ground while roused on the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole then came into the stretch in the three path and lacked the needed response. MILITARY ROAD was urged early then settled on the outside, came back under urging near the half-mile pole, went around the turn in the four path and capitulated.

UNLIMITEDPOTENTIAL got brushed at the start by NOTED due to pressure from CHELONIAN breaking inwards, vied briefly with a pair of rivals before establishing sole command with six and a half furlongs to run, showed the way in hand two then three wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide for home, edged clear under a drive to prevail. CICCIOBELLO hustled from the gate, chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on clear of the rest for the place honors. MR. PAPAGIORGIO vied early on with a pair of foes before chasing four then three wide coming under urging with seven-sixteenths remaining, went four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. POWER SEEKER three wide in pursuit, got coaxed along with seven-sixteenths to run, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. CHELONIAN broke in at the start bumping NOTED into UNLIMITEDPOTENTIAL, vied briefly loosely between foes, then raced three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, got ridden along at the seven-sixteenths marker, swung just off the inside at the head of the stretch, tired. NOTED got bumped at the start by the breaking inwards CHELONIAN and in turn brushed UNLIMITEDPOTENTIAL, chased five then four wide under urging from the three-eighths pole, angled five to six wide for home and trailed throughout.

KYLE'S MOM chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled outside MOON GATE near the quarter pole and was carried out five wide by that rival when she went four wide into upper stretch, came in under a right handed crop in tandem with that foe straightened away engaging MOON GATE in head to head combat, brushed that rival just outside the eighth pole, then dug in gamely to prevail on the wire. MOON GATE vied inside a pair of rivals while along the inside through to the nine-sixteenths before shaking away to sole command half a mile from home, continued along the rail through the turn and came under pressure near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch carrying her main danger five wide, then came inwards in concert with KYLE'S MOM straightened away before being brushed by that rival just outside the eighth pole when headed narrowly for command, dug in dueling through to the finish in game fashion but was ultimately bested on the line. AH CA IRA chased along the inside until tipped to the two path at the seven-sixteenths marker, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun two to three wide for home and offered up a mild kick. SANTAGATA vied with a pair of rivals from the three path through to the nine-sixteenths marker, then chased just off the inside coming under a ride three furlongs out, faded through the latter portion of the turn, swung three wide into upper stretch, weakened while passing more tired rivals through to the finish. AMITY ISLAND chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, tired. TOXIC GIRL chased two then three wide under a ride from the three-eighths pole, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, tired. GREGORIAN SOLO chased five then four wide under encouragement from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch and tired. SHE'S COMPLICATED veered out at the break, then advanced stoutly to vie outside a pair of rivals through to the nine-sixteenths, tucked three wide into the turn and came under urging at the

five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and tired through to the finish. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run focusing on the top two finishers. After review, the result was allowed to stand before the race was declared official.
