SHOP LIFTING was hustled from the gate, moved to the lead inside the three-quarter pole, showed the way under pressure to her outside, shook clear along the rail on the turn, extended the advantage late on that bend, was put to a strong hand-ride into upper stretch, came under three pops of a right-handed crop between the eighth-pole and the sixteenth-pole, was put back to a hand-ride into the final sixteenth then eased up in the final strides while much the best. SHIRL'S DELIGHT was restless in the gate, moved out early then was urged along at the rear, went around the turn in the two to three path, turned into upper stretch under the crop and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE broke out and was last of the four to commence, tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, chased in the three then four path on the turn, dropped back while remaining on her inside lead in upper stretch and capitulated. WIMBERLY showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back in the two path early on the turn, moved to the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and retreated.

ADELEKE established the front shortly after the start and showed the way just off the inside and then along the inside, came under pressure from the runner up midway on the turn and remain patiently handled until roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, then drew clear under a drive to prevail. PISTOL LIZ ABLAZEN coaxed from the start, chased four wide down the backstretch until tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths and advanced on the leader applying pressure through the latter portion of the turn, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, kept on to chase the winner home clear of the rest and along second best. FLOGE coaxed from the gate, chased two then three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. WHISTLER'S STYLE chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn and came under encouragement with seven-sixteenths to run, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired. GOLDCREST forwardly placed three wide down the backstretch, tucked to the two path into the turn and came under coaxing at the three-eighths in retreat, cornered three wide into upper stretch and was eased home through to the finish.

AMERICA'S HONOR brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, chased the pace on the outside of the leader, made a bid in the three path midway through the turn, took the advantage outside the furlong marker, shook clear under the crop outside the sixteenth-pole then drew away while placed under a hand-ride from that point to the finish. SMOKEY PLACES was reluctant to load, brushed with a rival while breaking in front, was hustled clear then taken under a strong hold before being let out near the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the turn, was asked under threat with three furlongs to run, lost the advantage to the winner outside the furlong marker and proved no match while just able to get the place. NICO'S DERBY RUN broke in and bumped with a rival, settled at the rear, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was roused while moving from the three path to the five path on the turn, drifted in some under two pops of a right-handed crop while still on his inside lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead nearing the furlong marker and just missed the place while clear for the show. BRODERICK settled on the outside, was roused in the four path on the turn, remained on his inside lead in upper stretch and failed to respond. LAIRD OF MAGNOLIA was bumped at the start, moved up under urging with five furlongs to run, chased in the two path while hard ridden on the turn and came up empty.

BIG RICH got steadied at the start when NEPTUNE BEACH broke inwards, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to steadily gain through the stretch and was just up on the wire to score. SOLO EMPIRE hustled from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, took the inside route into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat and was nailed on the line. BROWN DON'T STOP coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, advanced to press the pace from the three-eighths until spinning three wide at the quarter pole, got shaken off straightened away and weakened in the late stages. NEPTUNE BEACH broke in at the start forcing BIG RICH to steady, raced three wide through the first turn before chasing four wide thereafter, came under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and tired. OLLIE CAN DANCE got loaded into the gate by being back in, brushed the near side stall at the start and was away last, chased just off the inside through the first turn and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, went four to five wide through the far turn before cornering four wide at the head of the stretch and trailed throughout.

GRAND CASH coaxed from the start, chased four then three wide coming under urging at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, ran on rallying with TIOTE to his inside, got repelled as a pair by the top one but won the battle for the place honors in the final jumps. TIOTE coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside coming under a ride at the three-eighths pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, kept on under a drive but was ultimately rebuffed by the top one and then collared for the place honors while clear for the show. HAVE A CIGAR got bumped at the start by TOTAL SILENCE, who broke inwards, and conceded three to four lengths to the front, chased five wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, went eight wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. TOTAL SILENCE broke in at the start bumping HAVE A CIGAR, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, took the inside route into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. ALZERO broke in at the start and was corrected, chased three wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened. KISMEHOLDMETHRLME chased three to four paths off the inside until tucked inside through the turn, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and made no impact. RECURRING REVENUE lunged at the break, raced forwardly placed three then two wide, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun three wide into upper stretch and faltered in the stretch. FIRST PITCH grew a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, tossed his head at the break getting away last and conceding six to seven lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, cornered four to five wide into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact. STATE PARK coaxed

from the start, chased six then four wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, went four wide into upper stretch and never threatened.
