MILES AND MILES along the inside into the first turn, tipped out four wide one mile from home carrying out DOMINICAN PIRATE briefly before advancing on the front to take command seven furlongs from home, angled in to settle along the inside down the backstretch showing the way in hand, remained patiently handled through the far turn and cut the corner into upper stretch, got roused straightened away and went clear under a drive to prevail. LUCKY DRAGON coaxed from the gate, crossed to the inside into the first turn showing the way until displaced from the front with seven furlongs to go, chased briefly along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors by a head on the wire. ASSET MANAGEMENT coaxed from the start, chased along the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, ran on to miss for the place honors while safe for the show. MAGNI coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside coming under a ride three furlongs out, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and kept on through to the finish. DOMINICAN PIRATE broke out at the start brushing POWERED BY COAL, chased three then two wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, tipped four to five wide for home, made no late headway. POWERED BY COAL got brushed at the start by DOMINICAN PIRATE, chased three wide under urging from the three-eighths marker, went six to seven wide at the top of the stretch and weakened. DEAR CHAIRMAN stumbled at the start, chased three then two wide under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

EVERLYS GIRL settled off the pace, moved in with about six furlongs to run, was asked while saving ground on the turn, chased under a drive into the final furlong, gained to make a bid in the final sixteenth and got up in the final strides to narrowly prevail. CONDIMENT GIRL tossed her head slightly then came outward at the start, settled on the outside, rallied quickly in the five then four path on the turn, closed strongly to get the lead in upper stretch, led under a drive until the final strides but was denied while able to get the place. RAW POWER was last into stride, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the two path on the turn, came under the crop before the five-sixteenths pole, spun into upper stretch in the three path then moved out and gained willingly to get the show. HALO CITY was urged along at the rear, raced in the three path for most of the turn then dropped to the rail, angled out in upper stretch and gained while improving position for the last spot in the superfecta. FIND YOUR JOY stumbled at the start but came out in front, showed the way on the inside of rivals, moved clear outside the half-mile pole, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch, fought with that foe into the final furlong and weakened. JOLLY MISS JILL showed speed between foes then prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, dropped back late on the backstretch, retreated in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and capitulated. SISTER LINDA was hustled from the gate, showed speed then tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, retreated in the four path on the turn, floated into the six path entering upper stretch and was eased but walked off.

BERNIETAKESCHARGE got bumped at the start by WEIGH THE RISKS due to pressure from KID'S LAST LAUGH, duelled from the two path with AUSSIE GIRL to her outside, tucked inside through the turn and was joined three deep by the runner up midway on the turn, shook off the middle rival in tandem and was under some pressure from WEIGH THE RISKS and came under urging just outside the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch shaking off that rival straightened away and drew clear under a drive to prevail. WEIGH THE RISKS received a glancing bump from KID'S LAST LAUGH at the break when that rival stepped outwards and in turn bumped BERNIETAKESCHARGE, chased four then three wide advancing on the duel at the three-eighths to stack outside them, had the middle rival bow out through the latter portion of the turn and was latched on the leader spinning three wide for home under a drive, got shaken off straightened away proving no match for that rival while along clear of the rest and second best. KID'S LAST LAUGH broke out a step at the start bumping WEIGH THE RISKS into BERNIETAKESCHARGE, chased three wide until tucked briefly to the two path into the turn before heading back three wide when placed to a ride at the three-eighths pole, tipped four wide at the top of the stretch and weakened but was just up for the show honors on the wire. AUSSIE GIRL (IRE) broke out at the start and was corrected, led briefly before being engaged in head to head combat with BERNIETAKESCHARGE to her inside seven furlongs from home, knocked heads four then three wide down the backstretch getting eased off briefly before coming again tucked to the two path into the turn, got joined outside by the runner up and came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths between foes, faded through to the quarter pole and went two to three wide for home, then weakened in the stretch and was nailed on the wire for the show honors. BON ADIEU stumbled at the start, chased five then four wide under a ride with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide at the head of the lane, tired.

EMIRATES ROAD got bumped at the start by LIBERTE DE BAYEUX, who broke out a step, chased four then three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, shying out straightened away an additional two paths under a left handed crop, had the rider go to the right hand and corrected rallying to take command a furlong out, then shied out under a left handed crop once more while drawing clear to the finish, getting corrected again nearing the wire. LIBERTE DE BAYEUX broke out at the start bumping the aforementioned foe, showed the way in hand three then two wide coming under coaxing just outside the eighth pole before being set down three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught a furlong out, ran on well clear of the rest to be along second best. SHADOW DRAGON seven paths off the inside in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked four then three wide coming under urging at the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to secure the show honors. TRULLI MAGIC was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, raced off the pace under coaxing, came under stronger encouragement in the three path on the turn, moved to the four path outside the quarter-pole then came five wide into the stretch and improved for the show. LADY RAINICORN was urged along near the middle of the field, dropped from the two path to the rail late on the turn, shifted out into upper stretch, passed the three-sixteenths in the four path, lugged in under extra right-rein pressure

in the drive, came between horses late and just missed the trifecta. VINO SAMARA disputed the pace on the outside of several opponents, vied in the four then three path on the turn, dropped to the two path while inching clear late on that bend, lost the advantage into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened. TWIRLY was ridden along on the outside, angled in outside the half-mile pole, raced in the three path on the turn, came out into upper stretch, passed the three-sixteenths pole in the seven path and failed to rally. MOONTOWN chased the pace on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went around the turn in the four path, moved to the three path into the stretch, drifted out in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. TIZN'T ANYMORE was urged along off the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole and was no factor. ELENI was reluctant to load then finally shoved backwards into the gate from the front, disputed the pace between horses under urging, vied in the two path early on the turn, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole then moved to the inside and tired. RARE SOCIETY was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths then drifted in, raced at the rear under urging, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. LADY OF MERCIA was hustled from the gate, contested the pace between foes, dropped back in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and faded.
