PRETTY MAGICAL bumped soundly with a rival at the start, showed speed on the inside of a foe, moved in entering the main-track, showed the way under pressure to her outside, lost the advantage under urging while along the rail midway through the turn, duelled with the runner-up into the final furlong, regained the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, brushed with the runner-up into the final sixteenth then moved clear under strong handling. MATERIAL GIRL prompted the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure in the two path early on the turn, took a short lead with three furlongs to run, was asked at the five-sixteenths pole, duelled outside of the winner under a right-handed crop while remaining on her left lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead outside the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed crop shortly thereafter, lost the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, brushed with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the place. FARM HOUSE was hustled from the start then coaxed along while well placed just off the pace, chased in the two then three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and weakened but was well clear for the show. WILLFUL MAMA bumped hard with an opponent at the start then was hustled, moved out early then was urged along on the outside, chased in the three to four path going around most of the turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend and had nothing left. GABBY'S LEGACY bumped hard with rivals on both sides at the start then dropped back while tossing her head some, spotted the front a few lengths, was urged along at the rear, traveled around most of the turn in the two path, shifted to the four path outside the quarter-pole, came into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. ST. ADDIE moved out early then settled off the pace, was roused while in the three to five path on the turn and faltered.

CENTRAL CASTING coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand three then two wide, got set down spinning two to three wide into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to prevail. BROADWAY LIGHTS hustled from the start, chased four then three wide under a ride from the three-eighths pole, swung four wide for home, proved no match for the top one while keeping on clear of the rest for the place honors. HONORABLE BECKY chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, improved position to secure the show honors. CAROL SAID NO chased five then four wide coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, tipped six wide into upper stretch, tired. HONEY IN THE BANK coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside placed to urging at the half mile pole, spun three wide into upper stretch in retreat and was eased home through to the finish, then walked off under her own power and was reported to have bled.

FINDANAME settled well off the pace, saved ground under urging on the turn, swung out while gaining into upper stretch, reached the five path around the three-sixteenths pole while put to a left-handed crop then came out a touch, rallied outside under a solid hand-ride to get the lead inside the furlong marker and prevailed under a continued solid hand-ride to the finish. BIG EGO tracked the pace down the backstretch, dropped from the four path to the three path early on the turn then chased, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong then made a bid, fought with the winner to the finish and missed while able to get the place. ALLOFASUDDENLEE was hustled to the front then showed the way with a clear advantage, rounded the turn in the two path, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, led under a drive into the final furlong then was overtaken. BREAK THE FALL was well placed just off the pace, chased in the three path for most of the turn then dropped to the rail, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong then moved out and weakened. SOLOMINI'S LEGACY bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along in the four path on the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch, drifted in again outside the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. NEPTUNE BEACH settled near the back, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, rounded the turn in the three path and was no factor. MAGIC BEACH broke in and bumped with an opponent, was forwardly placed on the outside, traveled around the turn in the five path under urging and came up empty. DR HIGH dropped well behind under urging, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and showed little.

PURPOSE chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking four then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled five wide into upper stretch, angled in two paths nearing the eighth pole, rallied to steadily gain through to the finish and was up in the last jumps to the wire. TOWER TWENTY TWO settled off the pace, chased in the four path for most of the turn, dropped to the three path while gaining outside the quarter-pole, took a short lead in upper stretch, battled outside of SABBY SUNSET into the final sixteenth and just held under strong urging. AH CA IRA stumbled at the start but broke with the rest of the field, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the three path on the turn, gained in the five path under a right-handed crop into the stretch, was switched to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, drifted out inside that marker and closed well but was too late while up for the place. SABBY SUNSET went to the front then showed the way, vied inside on the turn, was asked late on that bend, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought on with the winner into the final sixteenth but was outfinished then lost the place while well clear for the show. MARY IN THE IRONS was urged along at the rear, moved from the three path to the four path on the turn, was pulled in by her rider to illicit a lead change in upper stretch then moved

out and improved position without threatening. BROKEN ZIPPER stalked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path on the turn and tired. ESTHER'S SALAD was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path and failed to respond. TALE OF THE TAIL tracked the pace, chased in the two path on the turn and capitulated. I AM EV settled towards the rear, came under urging before the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. FRANKIE HICCUPS was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace, came up empty in the two path early on the turn and retreated.
