TARPAULIN settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the four path, lugged inward in the stretch, was guided out inside the furlong marker, rallied outside while continuing to lug in, closed well to make a bid in the final sixteenth and got up to narrowly prevail under heavy right-rein guidance. DEREK'S LAW settled off the pace, chased in the three path on the turn, gained to take the lead in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth, came out a bit late and was denied while able to get the place. PANAGIOTIS was hustled from the gate, settled off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path under urging on the turn, chased the leader willingly into the final sixteenth, checked in tight between foes late and held the show. CAMM' DUKE was hustled from the gate, disputed the pace on the outside, moved clear leaving the backstretch, went around most of the turn in the two path then dropped to the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the runner-up in upper stretch, fought on well into the final sixteenth but was outfinished. AIRBORNE ELITE was hustled from the gate, disputed the pace on the inside of an opponent, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and tired. ARI'S MAGIC turned his head at the start and was away awkwardly while off a bit slow, settled towards the rear, went around most of the turn in the two path under urging, shifted to the four path outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH
