MERCILESANIHILATOR broke in at the start and was corrected, chased four wide and was given a notch to work with seven-sixteenths to go and advanced through the turn taking over narrow command swinging three then two wide into upper stretch, got roused near the three-sixteenths marker and edged clear under a drive to prevail. RESIDE brushed the off side stall at the start, prompted the leader from the outside three wide advancing to take command with five-sixteenths to go, yielded the front spinning from the two path into upper stretch, tipped out three wide straightened away and kept on to the finish to secure the place honors. LUCKY LARRY struck the off side stall at the start when breaking outwards, chased five then four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide half a mile from home, came under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. RAGING SEA CAPTAIN chased just off the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, angled four wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish. KID RICH coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand along the inside under some pressure from RESIDE to the outside, came under coaxing from the two path three furlongs out, yielded the front with five-sixteenths to run and took the inside route into upper stretch, then folded in the drive.
