POWER SEEKER was coaxed along towards the front, chased in the four path on the turn, gained into the stretch then made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, took the lead shortly thereafter, responded well under a strong hand-ride in the final furlong and proved best while coming in some late. BREW PUB disputed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn, was roused late on that bend, battled under a drive in upper stretch, kept on in the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the place. BEST BET drifted out early while going to the front, angled in entering the main-track, vied in the two path while inside of a foe on the turn, was given his cue late on that bend, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but was well clear for the show. BAD LARRY was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, moved from the two path to the five path on the turn and failed to respond. LOST IN ROME was hustled from the gate then urged along near the back, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn and came up empty. BOSSMAKINBOSSMOVES was urged along at the rear on the outside, dropped from the five path to the three path on the turn and faltered then was eased before being transported off the track via equine ambulance while reported to have bled.

SHILLING bobbled at the break, advanced to tussle briefly with SECANE before taking narrow command six furlongs from home, showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from that rival, came under coaxing three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to score. BELIEVABLE coaxed from the gate, chased five then four wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, spun three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one, ran on to secure the place honors. SECANE led early on and then prompted the pace of SHILLING from the outside three then two wide coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, spun three then two wide for home, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to preserve the show honors. DAY TO DAY broke in at the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tipped out to the five path straightened away and weakened. SPA PROSPECTOR broke out at the start, chased four then three wide coming under encouragement midway on the turn, cornered three to four wide into upper stretch, tired.

RARE SOCIETY was hustled from the gate, chased the pace on the outside, went around the turn in the three then four path, was driven into the stretch in the three path and weakened but was clear for the show. PATIENCE N GRACE settled on the outside, was urged along in the four then five path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the seven path and failed to threaten. NERI bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along on the far outside, moved from the four path to the six path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the eighth path and was no factor. BODEGAS settled off the pace, steadied in traffic nearing the half-mile pole, was roused in the two path on the turn, moved to the three path outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the four path and came up empty.
