MAP OF THE MOON bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, swung into the stretch in the five path, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late and prevail. BELIEVE IN MAGIC showed speed then chased the pace, vied in the two to three path on the turn, battled outside of BEACH HEIST under a drive in upper stretch, brushed with that foe while getting a narrow lead near the eighth-pole, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while just able to get the place. BEACH HEIST went to the front then showed the way, vied inside to the two path on the turn, battled with the runner-up under a drive in upper stretch, drifted off approaching the furlong marker then brushed with that foe and lost the advantage, fought on well to the finish and just missed the place but was clear for the show. HARK THEANGELSSING was ridden along on the outside then moved in, went around the turn in the two path, chased under a drive into the final furlong, moved out just inside the sixteenth-pole and lacked

the needed kick while up for the last spot in the superfecta. SWEET MONTREAL was urged along off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out outside the furlong marker, angled in outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly to just miss the superfecta. LIT SHIP settled under some urging, went around the turn in the three then four path, turned into the stretch in the six path and lacked the needed response. VELCAMP broke through the front of the gate prior to the start then was brought back around and reloaded, came outward at the start, was urged along towards the rear, raced inside to the two path on the turn and was no factor. SHOULD'VE bumped with a foe at the start, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, chased under a drive into the final furlong, was taken in hand near the sixteenth-pole and faltered. CATALONIA chased the pace on the outside, rounded the turn in the three then four path and tired. YAUDACITY broke through the front of the gate prior to the start then was brought back around and reloaded, broke out and hit the gate, raced in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path and was no factor. SILICIUM (FR) was off a step slow then ducked out, spotted the front several lengths, angled in at the rear, went around the turn in the two then three path, came out into upper stretch and also was no factor.

BAY OF BENGAL showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, then dug in and held well to prevail. GENE AND JUDE settled tracking the leader from the two path in closest aim, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive running on willingly to secure the place honors. PROVE settled tracking along the inside into the first turn, suddenly cow kicked SALT SPARTAN with his right hind leg in that rival's front left leg while he was just askew and behind him in the two path forcing that foe to fall heavily, continued along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and kept on to procure the show honors. FULLY BOOKED coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside coming under a ride nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. MIDDLE MARKET tracked the pace along the inside coming

under urging near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish. CAPTCHA coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, bid three wide into upper stretch, then weakened to the wire. KULAPAT saved ground in pursuit from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and made no headway. ENGLISH CASTLE settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, stumbled over the fallen rival directly in front and had the rider somehow stay onboard through great agility but lost the irons as a result, was eased along down the backstretch until pulled up near the seven-sixteenths, then got vetted on track and was walked to the main course and transported from that course via the equine ambulance. REYNOLDS CHANNEL settled just off the inside near the tail of the field, attempted to alter around a fallen foe and bobbed, lost ground and angled out wide through the first turn and was eased along down the backstretch before being pulled up near the half mile pole, was vetted on track and walked off under his own power. SALT SPARTAN coaxed from the gate, raced just off the inside just off the pace into the first turn, fell heavily just inside the six and a half furlong marker when getting his left front leg kicked out in a cow kick by PROVE, who was in front and to the inside, which forced two rivals to alter and bobble and stumble around him, rose to his feet and ran off bucking and got apprehended by the outrider after bucking due to the slipped saddle, then got vetted on track and walked off under his own power. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the incident in the first turn. After review, the result stood and the race was declared official.
