COLLECT THE DATA bobbled at the start and recovered outwards brushing with MONETARY MONARCH, showed the way in hand just off the inside under some pressure from that rival to the outside, tucked inside through the turn, got roused spinning from the two path into upper stretch, drew off under a drive to prevail. MIDTOWN LIGHTS coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one, ran on to secure the place honors. EMBRACEABLE GAL chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. FAST AND FRISKY coaxed from the start, chased four then three wide under urging from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch, weakened. MONETARY MONARCH got brushed at the break by COLLECT THE DATA, who recovered outwards from a bobble, prompted the leader from the outside three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and tired. AH CA IRA chased five then four wide coming under urging three furlongs out, went seven wide into upper stretch, tired. MITOLE'S GIRL chased along the inside through until tipped three wide near the half mile pole, went four wide through the turn, angled in to spin just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.

VACATION DANCE bumped with a rival at the start, dropped in while settling off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out while put to a drive in upper stretch, rallied between horses into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up in the final stride. CYCLONITE was well placed just off the pace, stalked in the three path on the turn, gained to make a bid in upper stretch, took the lead inside the furlong marker, led until the final stride but was denied while clear for the place. CUANDO was well placed just off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path, chased the leader in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. BERGEN broke out and hit the gate, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch in the three path under the crop then shifted further out, chased the leader in the drive and lacked the needed kick. TUNISIAN SPRING settled off the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path, came into the stretch in the four path then moved further out, chased in the drive and also lacked the needed kick. LANDING CRAFT went to the front then showed the way under pressure to his outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the runner-up inside the furlong marker and weakened. LAUNCH CONTROL broke out and bumped with a foe then was hustled, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three then two path on the turn, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. GASLIGHT DANCER was urged along at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. OPERATION TORCH veered out at the start and was off a bit slow, raced in the three path on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and was no factor.

BELAROSA dueled three then two wide with BROCKCASSO to her inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in and held safe to the finish. FRAUDSTER tracked the pace along the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. ALLURING ANGEL (GB) established a forward position early, raced in the three path on the first turn, moved to the lead before passing the wire for the first time, rounded the second turn in the two path, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside on the final turn, came out under urging into upper stretch, responded well in the drive and held under steady urging. NO SHOW SAMMY JO (GB) was bumped by a rival early then shuffled back along the rail, saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, rounded the second turn in the two path, continued towards the rear, was roused in the three path on the final turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and finished with good energy to garner the place. BEACH BOMB (SAF) bumped with a foe at the start, went to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, lost the lead before the wire for the first time then dropped just off the pace, saved ground from that point, was given her cue on the final turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. GRAYOSH saved ground while reserved on the inside, was roused near the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, was taken in hand very briefly just inside the sixteenth-pole and improved position. WAY TO BE MARIE settled towards the front in the two to three path, was roused on the final turn and lacked the needed response. FUN WITH FLAGS (IRE) was caught in the four path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, rounded the second turn in the two path, continued just behind the leader, was asked in the two path on the final turn, chased into upper stretch and weakened. ALIMARA (FR) was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, traveled around the first turn in the three path, settled at the rear, saved ground on the second turn, was roused in the three path on the final turn and failed to threaten. AMBER CASCADE was guided in early then bumped with a foe, settled off the inside in the two path,

raced behind horses while off heels coming to the quarter-pole, moved out while roused in upper stretch and failed to rally. LADY FIREFOOT saved ground towards the rear, was roused in the two path on the final turn, turned into the stretch in the four path then moved further out, was crowded between horses around the furlong marker and also failed to rally. BROCKNARDINI bumped with a rival at the start, was bumped early then forced into another foe, tossed her head and was taken up into the first turn, saved ground on that bend, settled off the pace while moving out, went around the second in the three path, settled outside on the backstretch, was roused in the three then four path on the final turn and failed to respond.
