MUTAAWID dropped towards the rear, raced in the three path on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, raced under some urging late on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the three then four path, turned into the stretch in the five path, rallied on the far outside, closed strongly to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, battled with two foes to the finish and prevailed under good handling. DIRAND (IRE) was well placed just off the pace on the inside, moved to the two path near the five-sixteenths pole, waited while lacking room into upper stretch, altered in from behind horses inside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied to make a bid near the furlong marker, held a short lead outside the sixteenth-pole, fought with two rivals to the finish and missed while just able to get the place. SPACE LEGEND (IRE) was reserved in the two path, raced behind horses at the rear going around the far turn, shifted to the three path while roused into upper stretch, altered in inside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole, battled with the top two to the finish and missed while clear clear for the show. DUPONT LAW (IRE) raced in the four path on the first turn, staked the pace on the outside without cover, was given his cue in the three then four path on the far turn, chased under a drive in the stretch and lacked the needed kick. INTERCEPTOR moved in early, was rated in the two path, dropped back some while moving to the three path near the five-sixteenths pole, spun into upper

stretch in the four path and lacked the needed response. KING D'ORO moved from the rail to the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while saving ground on the far turn and failed to rally. CARD TRICK prompted the pace on the outside in the two to three path, was asked on the far turn, led under a drive into the final furlong, lost the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole and tired. CREATE TROUBLE went to the front, showed the way on the inside, was asked on the far turn, drifted out in upper stretch and gave way. BEUYS (IRE) departed the gate with the body of the field, quickly refused to go forward and was pulled up then walked off.
