ECHO IN ETERNITY stalked the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, was given her cue at the quarter-pole, chased outside under a drive into the final furlong, gained the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. MAGGIE T was hustled to the front, showed the way under pressure to her outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, moved off the rail while put to a left-handed crop in upper stretch, led until outside the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken but held the place. BOOK OF WISDOM dropped back under urging then angled in with about five furlongs to run, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, gained late on that bend, swung out to the five path into upper stretch, remained on her inside lead until near the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead and finished willingly while flattening out some and missed the place but earned the show. GHOSTLY GIRL was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, chased the leader into the final furlong and weakened. SPRING MAGIC was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace, saved ground while drafting behind the leader on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick.

SOCIAL HOUR forwardly placed from the gate, knocked heads on the front under a firm hold six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide into the turn, got set down spinning four wide into upper stretch, took over sole command at the three-sixteenths, edged away to inside the eighth pole, then dug in and held safe to prevail. COMPLEX MUSIC four then three wide in pursuit, got coaxed along with five-sixteenths to go, tipped five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors. FREE DANCE broke out a step at the start bumping PANAGIOTIS, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then two to three wide through the turn coming under urging three furlongs out, went seven wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild bid. AERO STAR struck the near side stall at the start and broke forward despite it, showed the way briefly before being engaged in head to head combat near the nine-sixteenths marker, dueled in hand three then two wide, continued just off the inside at the quarter pole before straightened away closer to the rail, got headed for the front near the three-sixteenths pole and kept on through to the finish. CAPT JAX PARROW coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside coming under a ride nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the end. PANAGIOTIS got bumped lightly at the start by FREE DANCE, who broke out a step, chased five then four wide under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened.

MERICA'S BACK bumped with a rival at the start while brushing with another foe, went to the front then showed the way with a clear advantage, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, responded well when put to the crop in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth and just held under steady urging. TWOHONESTMISCHIEF was bumped at the start then forced into another foe, was urged early then settled off the pace, moved up near the nine-sixteenths pole, tracked in the two path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the three path, chased the winner on the outside into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth and just missed while well clear for the place. POPPY'S TICKET settled outside under some urging, came under stronger encouragement in the four path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. SPEIGHTFUL STORM settled off the pace, moved out a path outside the half-mile pole, was roused in the two path on the turn and failed to rally. KAZ OIL CHANGER brushed the outside of the gate at the start, was urged along at the rear, went around the turn in the two to three path, spun into the stretch in the four path, moved out around the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. GUILTY broke in and bumped with a foe, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path then dropped back, drifted out near the furlong marker and tired. COUNTER MOVE brushed with a foe at the start, was well placed just off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.
