ECHO IN ETERNITY stalked the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, was given her cue at the quarter-pole, chased outside under a drive into the final furlong, gained the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. MAGGIE T was hustled to the front, showed the way under pressure to her outside, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, moved off the rail while put to a left-handed crop in upper stretch, led until outside the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken but held the place. BOOK OF WISDOM dropped back under urging then angled in with about five furlongs to run, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, gained late on that bend, swung out to the five path into upper stretch, remained on her inside lead until near the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead and finished willingly while flattening out some and missed the place but earned the show. GHOSTLY GIRL was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, chased the leader into the final furlong and weakened. SPRING MAGIC was hustled from the gate then well placed just off the pace, saved ground while drafting behind the leader on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick.
