SMALLCHANGEGEEP chased just off the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out over a trio heads apart, then edged clear to the finish to prevail. LUCKY DRAGON established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside under some pressure from POWERED BY COAL, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught a furlong out, ran on to preserve the place honors gamely on the wire. POWERED BY COAL prompted the leader from the outside three then two wide coming under urging near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch and bumped PROJECTABILITY straightened away, dug in under a drive bumping that rival near the eighth pole, then traded minor bumps and leans through to the sixteenth marker while keeping on to garner the show honors. GOOD COP shied out at the start when CARLIN CONTENTION broke outwards and bumped PROJECTABILITY who broke in a step, chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. PROJECTABILITY broke in at the start and was bumped by GOOD COP, chased five then four wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch and was bumped by POWERED BY COAL straightened away, dug in shoulder to shoulder with that rival and was bumped once more at the eighth pole, then traded small bumps and leans through to the sixteenth pole before weakening in the late going. CARLIN CONTENTION broke out at the start and was corrected, chased along the inside under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. SAINT SOLOMON urged from the gate, chased four then three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide for home and tired. SOUL MAKOSSA grew detached at the tail of the field soon after the start, chased along the inside coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, tipped three to four wide into upper stretch and trailed.
