BOLD JOURNEY was urged along off the pace, shifted from the two path to the four path early on the turn, gained on that bend, chased the winner on the outside in the stretch, loomed a threat in the final furlong and finished with good courage but missed while just able to get the place. GENERAL BANKER was urged along off the pace, chased inside to the two path on the turn, pursued the leaders while remaining on his lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead at the furlong marker, moved in late and finished willingly to just miss the place while clear for the show. ACOUSTIC AVE was hustled from the gate, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied along the rail while asked on the turn, lost the advantage to the winner into the stretch and gave way.
