ETERNALLY GRATEFUL showed no early speed while racing widest of all but made a mid track rally to run down the leader in the stretch run and was up in the final jumps. TOOMANYNAMES went to the front to set the pace before pulling away going into the stretch but was denied in the final jumps. SUBSIDIZE raced near the back while saving ground before showing late interest going into the stretch but was not match for the top two. NINE LIVES ELMER raced near the back early then advanced three wide to be in contention going into the turn but couldn't catch the leader and gave way in the stretch. MISTER MAFIOSO prompted the pace from off the rail to the turn then faded and lacked a rally.
