GREAT THINGSTOCOME rushed away to take a clear lead to set all the pace before pulling away late. SPEAK NOW tracked the leaders from the inside before moving up midway through the turn but was no match for the winner and was able to hold on for the place. SIEMPRE NAMAN showed no early speed to the turn then made a rail bid on the turn and continued on to deep stretch but missed the place. BOSS GIRL broke well then settled in the middle of the pack from off the rail while racing evenly but was best of the rest. SKYLER'S DIVA was not a threat and outrun. I'M YOUR COCO vied for the lead from three wide to midway through the turn before falling back and lacked a rally in the stretch.
