SUBTLE HOOLIGAN was allowed to settle near the back before moving up after the half mile marker then tipped out to four wide in upper stretch and battled with MARKING BROADWAY to deep stretch where he make a late push to be up in the final yards. MARKING BROADWAY stalked the pace from four wide down the backstretch then moved up near the three furlong marker to engage the leader midway through the final turn and took the lead near the quarter pole but was challenged by SUBTLE HOOLIGAN in mid stretch and was outkicked to finish second best. PI TIME went to the front to set the pace from two wide before being headed midway through the final turn while matching strides inside of BEERS ON ME and MARKING BROADWAY but couldn't fend them off and was over taken near the eighth before weakening but held the show. BEERS ON ME pressed the pace from three wide down the backstretch before moving up to engage the leader midway through the final turn and fought gamely to the eighth pole but was empty late. DORMELLO'S LEGACY settled off the pace while saving ground to the top of the stretch but lacked room and shifted out to five wide near the eighth pole but was too late. BRIGGS ARMYPOWER was unhurried to the first turn while trailing the field and was outrun.
