SILVER SCREEN set the pace on a well measured lead in hand, kicked away at the top of the lane and was never seriously threatened coming home. FERRARI RED stalked the pace into the turn, gained position on the bend to threaten, failed to get passed the winner and ran-on willingly as second best. WHEELER DEALER was unhurried early to be at the rear of the main body of the field and showed good interest with a belated bid in the stretch to be along for the show. MOON SHINE TIME raced mid-pack to the top of the lane and showed some interest in the stretch with a mild bid. RIDIN SOLO pressed the pace down the backside and steadily faded from contention. HIGH PRINCE was outrun.
