T J MAGIC prompted the pace in the two path, was ridden in the four path around the turn, bid between foes at the top of the lane, ran on to sustain that bid into the final furlong, and inched ahead of an inner foe in the final strides. PRINCE OTTO vied for the lead in the three path, took command passing the quarter, was roused into the stretch, dug in gamely into the final furlong, but got edged out in the final strides. GRAN CHICO chased outside of foes in the four path, was coaxed along in the five path around the turn, bid outside of rivals at the top of the lane, and kept on but could not get past an inner pair. ARIZONA STEPHEN duelled for the lead inside, was roused while losing ground passing the quarter, and yielded down the stretch. JUST N JACK had a slow start and trailed, was coaxed along in the two path around the turn, but made no closing bid.
