BIG JACK laid up close along the inside, waited behind the leader around the turn, angled out the three path under rousing passing the eighth pole, and kicked past an inner foe around the sixteenth. FERRARI RED showed the way in the two path, waited around the turn before coming under a ride at the top of the lane, but was overtaken by an outer foe around the sixteenth. SUBSIDIZE stalked in the three path, bid under coaxing around the turn, but faded in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
