LADY OF DEVON stalked the pace four wide, dueled rivals in the stretch, inched past foe in the final sixteenth. SARAH'S COURT saved ground to press the early pace three wide between foes, dueled with rivals through the turn and stretch, gave way in the final sixteenth. MISTY MOOD settled off the pace, made an inside bid in the stretch to be up for the show award. OLIVIA'S CHOICE (IRE) pressed the pace in the two path between foes, faded in the final furlong. COMMUNICATIONISKEY claimed the early lead on the inside shortly after the start, relinquished the lead at the five sixteenths, angled out in the stretch but could not rally. POP CHART settled not too far behind the pace, retreated in the stretch. ADIOS MUCHACHAS stumbled at the start, trailed for most, passed tired rival. LA. GRAND SLAM rated five wide, retreated in the final quarter. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
