## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

CRESSONS LIL CHARM chased, ranged up under a ride in the four path around the turn, ran on to bid passing the eighth pole, led passing the sixteenth, and dug in to hold off an outer foe. UNKNOWN CALLER rated, was ridden in the four path around the turn, rallied to bid from the five path in the final sixteenth, but was denied by the game inner winner. PRINCESS VANELLOPE tracked inside, was ridden around the turn, and was one paced down the lane to edge out show in the final strides. TAP THE HEART set the pace inside, opened up under a ride around the turn, kept on from the three path in upper stretch, but yielded in the final sixteenth. HARDLY MISCHIEVOUS trailed, was driven in the two path around the turn, angled out to the five path in upper stretch, but made no impact. SQUARE FOOTAGE prompted the pace in the three path but weakened. PRINCESS AMANDA chased in the four path but retreated. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
