SENSE OF AWE led early off rail under inside pressure, forced issue inside into turn, took back lead after mid turn, opened up stretch, was kept to task to hold safe. MINERAL RIGHTS stalked four-wide, pressed three-wide turn, gave best stretch before tiring. NOT SO SWIFT pressed outside, short lead into turn, lost lead after mid turn, gave best stretch before tiring. CATCH THE DREAM stalked four-wide, rallied evenly widest. HIGH MILER stalked forced pace inside, tired stretch. THE WRIGHT WAY forced pace inside early, dropped back turn, faded.
