MAKENA'S JOY stalked three-four-wide, challenged stretch, took over mid stretch, drew out late. WITT'S TEN TOUCH moved to short lead inside, opened up turn, challenged inside and out stretch, turned back inside rival, gave best while giving way. J L COPPER tracked leader inside, challenged into stretch, bid to mid stretch, tired. COLONEL MUSTARD trailed to stretch, rallied wide. SHOCKING MALICE saved ground, advanced inside stretch. MOONMAN RULES broke a step slow, inside turn, lacked rally. BRINSON had outside speed under pressure, gave way into turn, faded late turn.
