CALMING FORCE dueled inside, opened up mid turn, increased margin into stretch. CATCH THE DREAM stalked duel off rail, rallied between horses for place. SHOCKING MALICE saved ground, rallied for show. CASUALLY CLASSY forced pace three-wide to mid turn, well placed to stretch, tired. COLONEL MUSTARD stalked widest, made a belated advance. J L COPPER dueled between horses, dropped back mid turn, tired stretch. WITT'S TEN TOUCH, back early, moved out five wide, three-wide turn, eased home from late turn.
