THATSWHATHESAID, seven-wide early, advanced four-wide turn, challenged stretch, dueled to mid stretch, shook inside rival, held well. CYBER STORM, six-wide early, stalked duel three-wide turn, rallied. ZIPPY SEASON, back early, advanced inside, finished well widest. MARY WHO steadied mildly at the break, advanced between horses, steadied mildly early turn, stalked duel between horses to stretch, rallied between horses. FLINTLOCK forced pace outside, dueled outside turn, dueled inside stretch, gave way mid stretch. SKYLAR'S FIRE stalked off rail, lacked needed rally. BLUE TANGO dueled between horses early, dueled inside turn, gave way eighth pole. SPORTING STAR dueled inside early, gave way into turn, well placed to stretch, faded. CHERBOURG stalked seven-eight wide early, widest turn, lacked rally. SPARKLE IN THE SKY stalked off rail, faded.
