CITY GIRL (FR) coaxed from the gate, raced forwardly placed along the inside into the first turn and seized narrow command through that bend under a hold with MO FOX GIVIN to her outside, got headed for the front six furlongs from home and eased off that rival to settle tracking just off the inside from just off the pace, tucked inside through the far turn and remained on hold until set down at the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to loosely split foes a furlong out and seized command nearing the sixteenth pole, then held safe over her barn mate to the finish. DYNAMIC PRICING (IRE) coaxed from the start, raced along the inside through the first turn, tipped out four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked two to three wide through the far turn and came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled six wide at the head of the stretch, dug in under a drive running on willingly to the finish to secure the place honors. LAURELIN (IRE) three then two wide through the first turn, tipped out five paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path at the seven-sixteenths marker and advanced on the leader through the turn coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive taking command a furlong from home among a quartet stacked across the track, got collared nearing the sixteenth pole and kept on to preserve the show honors clear of the rest. MO FOX GIVIN broke on top, raced forwardly placed just off the inside through the first turn and knocked heads briefly while in hand before taking sole command six furlongs out, showed the way three then two paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside through the far turn and came under urging with five-sixteenths top run as the aforementioned foe advanced outside, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a trio and yielded just outside the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. RACING COLORS lightly coaxed from the gate, raced two then three wide through the first turn, went five paths off the inside into the backstretch and was guided six paths off the rail when LAURELIN tipped out to her inside, tucked three wide through the far turn and was placed to a ride at the three-eighths pole, continued three wide into upper stretch and tired.
