KEEWAYDIN coaxed from the gate, established the front after the break and crossed to show the way in hand along the inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, edged away under a drive kept busy to the end. SHAPE NOTE three then two wide in pursuit, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch, ran on to garner the place honors. WAR STRIDE tracked the pace along the inside under a light hold when KEEWAYDIN crossed safely in front with nine-sixteenths to go, remained on hold cutting the corner into upper stretch in behind that same rival, remained tepidly handled down inside following KEEWAYDIN until tipped to the two path roused nearing the sixteenth marker, then ran on to secure the show honors while never fully extended. MASSETO (GB) coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside forwardly placed briefly and was taken hold and eased off with nine-sixteenths to go as rivals in front took to the rail to be last with half a mile to go, tipped to the two path through the turn coming under urging three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. Following an adjustment to the bridle by the gate crew prior to the field being loaded in the gate, STRAIGHT ARROW raced four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire but was outkicked. NIAGARA SKYLINE coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, weakened.

KUNSHAN BRIDGE chased the pace down the backstretch, gained in the three then two path early on the turn, made a bid between horses coming to the three-eighths pole, took a short advantage late on that bend, was roused at the quarter-pole then kicked clear under a left-handed crop in upper stretch and held under strong urging. RIYADH MOON chased the pace down the backstretch, moved from the rail to the two path late on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive then shifted out a path and finished willingly for the place. BURNINHUNKOFLOVE dropped back while urged along on the outside, moved from the five path to the four path early on the turn, chased outside into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. LOOMS BOLDLY was hustled to the front then moved in near the five-eighths pole, shifted from the two path to the inside while asked early on the turn, lost the advantage to the winner late on that bend, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened. SPIRIT DRAGON broke a half-step slow, was shut-off by NEUSCHWANSTEIN early then squeezed back, moved out at the rear then dropped in before the turn, went around that bend in the three path, drifted out in upper stretch and gained some ground but was no factor. NEUSCHWANSTEIN came in early and bothered SPIRIT DRAGON, raced just off the pace on the outside, gained under urging in the four then three path early on the turn, made a bid with three furlongs to run, dropped back while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead outside the furlong marker, was crowded while dropping back into the final furlong and tired.

JUST FOR LUCK tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, inched away briefly before coming under growing threat to the outside from IRON MAX and held safe to the finish. IRON MAX two then three wide in pursuit, got coaxed along with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch and was clipped behind by JACK AND JIM attempting to go over his heels, showed good courage to rally and threaten through the final furlong to the finish. MO TRUMP tracked the leader in closest aim just off the inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, tipped three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive between foes briefly a furlong out, then weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. ANNEXPERIENCE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside coming under urging at the five-sixteenths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat from flanking challengers and yielded just outside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late going. CABLE READY bobbed and was bumped in the hindquarters and spun out a bit by JACK AND JIM, chased two to three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. JACK AND JIM broke out brushing the off side stall and then bumping CABLE READY in the hindquarters when away last, saved ground near the rear of the field, began to tip out inside the five-sixteenths marker to be two then three wide nearing the quarter pole, hesitated briefly when unable to continue tipping out waiting IRON MAX to clear and then went to go over the heels of IRON MAX swinging four wide into upper stretch, clipped the back of that rival just after his right front leg was briefly between the back legs of IRON MAX, bobbed heavily and lost the rider straightening away, then got apprehended by the outrider after the finish and walked off under his own power.

NESSUNA PAGINA broke in at the start bumping SUNDAY BOY in concert with ILLMATIC, raced five then four paths off the inside briefly knocking heads with ILLMATIC before shaking away to sole command tucked to the two path with nine-sixteenths to go, remained just off the inside through the turn and came under light coaxing near the quarter pole, suddenly shied out just outside that station briefly carrying out ILLMATIC and SPIRIT OF NEW YORK a path before being corrected, the rider pausing, spun two to three wide into upper stretch re-engaged by the rider, got headed for the front with three-sixteenths to go, dug in inside a pair now along the rail when those rivals came inwards now to take the two and three path, got brushed by ILLMATIC a sixteenth out, seized back command and came out slightly under a left handed crop lightly bumping ILLMATIC into SPIRIT OF NEW YORK seventy yards from home and gamely fended off that pair to prevail on the line. the break who each broke his way, chased four then three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled seven wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. WIT STORM broke out at the start bumping SPIRIT OF NEW YORK into ILLMATIC, chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch until tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. HURRICANE KAZ chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, made no headway. There were two Objections by the riders of ILLMATIC and SPIRIT OF NEW YORK claiming interference in the stretch against NESSUNA PAGINA. After review, both objections were dismissed and the result was allowed to stand.

TAPWRITS TEMPER chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked into the turn three then two wide by midway, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied under a light drive to take command near the furlong marker, then drew clear and was geared down and back in hand inside the final sixteenth to the finish. TUTHILLTOWN bumped with a rival at the start, moved in while urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, rallied in the four path into the stretch, closed fast to get the lead at the furlong marker then drew clear under steady urging. GARDEN OF GRACE was urged along towards the rear, traveled around the turn in the two path, turned into upper stretch under a drive, remained on her inside lead until near the sixteenth-pole then swapped to

the proper lead and safely secured the place. WAITIN'ONAPROMISE bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, disputed the pace on the inside of a foe, vied along the rail while asked on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. STELLA FORTUNA was hustled from the gate, established a good position just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, turned into the stretch in the two path then dropped back closer to the inside, chased into the final furlong, moved out late and lacked the needed kick. RAYNHAM HALL settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was roused late on that bend, checked behind STELLA FORTUNA in upper stretch, was hesitantly ridden behind traffic until the sixteenth-pole, moved out while finally roused at that juncture and lost any chance then just missed the superfecta. ADROIT dropped back after the start, was urged towards the rear, rounded the turn in the two path and failed to threaten. AVERY'S WONDERLAND broke in at the start, was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the three path and lacked the needed response. COME MONDAY was urged along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the three to four path and failed to rally. MISCHIEVOUS JO bumped with a rival at the start, disputed the pace on the outside, vied in the three to four path on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and tired. JENNY WADE settled in the back half of the field, was urged along in the four then five path on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. TIZ IMPROBABLE broke in then hit the gate and was off a step slow, raced at the rear, dropped from the four path to the two path under urging on the turn and also failed to respond.
