HAFU chased just off the inside before tucking briefly inside with seven-sixteenths to go, slipped back to the two path three furlongs out and advanced on the duel swinging four wide into upper stretch when let out for the drive, rallied to collar the front a furlong from home, then edged clear to the finish to score. TWO DUCKS coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide with BOURBON HANGOVER to his inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, took sole and brief command with three-sixteenths to go before being caught a furlong out, kept on clear of the rest to be along second best. NOD TO TRAN chased three then two wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, tipped four wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals to the finish. DAW SAMAA hustled from the gate, led briefly early on then chased four then three wide coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide for home, weakened in the stretch. NO FILTER four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside into the turn, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened. BOURBON HANGOVER coaxed from the start, dueled inside of TWO DUCKS while along the rail, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths marker, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and yielded the front with three-sixteenths remaining, then tired through to the finish. OLIGARCH broke out a step at the start, chased five then four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, went six wide into upper stretch, tired.

MASSARAT dropped back early, settled at the rear under some restraint while saving ground, came off the inside leaving the second turn, remained unhurried at the back down the backstretch, was roused while moving from the three path to the five path on the far turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed strongly to make a bid coming to the sixteenth-pole and just got up under strong urging. RELAXX (FR) was rated under snug restraint in the two path, shifted to the three then four path while roused on the final turn, rallied into upper stretch, closed well to get the lead outside the furlong marker, led under a left-handed crop into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. SOL D'ORO was urged some to established early position, saved ground while rated just off the pace, waited while held up behind horses from the quarter-pole into upper stretch, altered out while put to urging near the three-sixteenths pole, chased behind the runner-up into the final sixteenth, found free space in front late and willingly earned the show. SNIPSNIPPITYSNIP stalked the pace on the outside in the three path without cover, made a bid on the final turn, was roused near the quarter-pole, took a brief lead in upper stretch then was headed by the runner-up, dropped back into the final furlong and was out-kicked then just missed the show. PROTECTIVE CUSTODY moved in while going to the front, showed the way on the inside through slow fractions while in hand, was asked under threat with a quarter-mile to run, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way. LADY FIREFOOT prompted the pace on the outside in the two path, was asked early on the final turn, vied between foes late on that bend, dropped back into upper stretch and capitulated. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times available.

MISS LAO lost her rear footing at the break and was away on top despite it, chased three wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, took over command with three-sixteenths to go, dug in under a drive edging away to the finish to prevail. LUNA MOTH chased three to four paths off the inside until tucked to the two path placed to prolonged coaxing half a mile from home, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. WHISTLER'S STYLE devoid of speed early on, grew detached at the tail of the field before making ground four then five paths off the rail down the backstretch nearing the half mile pole, went four wide through the turn coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to go and angled seven wide into upper stretch, then kept on to the wire. SANTAGATA coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, got caught three-sixteenths from home and kept on to the finish but was outfinished in the late stages. MY FIRST LOVE chased along the inside under urging from three furlongs out, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. NONNA LYNNE came outward at the start then angled in at the back, saved ground under a snug hold the first turn, settled at the rear, went around the far turn in the two path, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, came out some into upper stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. SARATOGA SNOW settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, raced between foes outside the sixteenth-pole and just missed the place while able to get the show. MOONLIGHT READY four wide in closest aim of the leader, advanced through the turn to knock heads briefly with that rival before seizing the front with five-sixteenths to go, cornered three to four wide into upper stretch patiently handled until roused near the three-sixteenths, edged clear to inside the eighth pole, dug in under threat from flanking challengers and held safe to prevail. VEKOMAS PLEASURE broke in at the start taking the vacant space left by APERITIF and ULTRA CAMEO who also broke inwards and veered inwards, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors. APERITIF broke in at the start filling the gap left vacant by the veering in ULTRA CAMEO, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, angled out seven to eight wide into upper stretch and closed well through the stretch to secure the show honors latching in the top pair in the final jumps. OKAY ANNIE chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn, came under encouragement with three furlongs to go, spun just off

the inside into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. MIDTOWN MISCHIEF broke out at the start forcing GALWAY GURL to steady in concert with BLUE AUTHENTICITY, who broke inwards, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. BERNINA EXPRESS coaxed from the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coaxed along from the five-sixteenths pole, went five wide into upper stretch and made no late headway. BABCIE chased three to four paths off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, tipped five wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals to the finish.
